Email: <u>Kenneth.gibson1@btinternet.com</u> Money Matters: Over the past months our church buildings have been requiring a considerable amount of attention in terms of maintenance and repairs. Even with building grants, the deficit for the year will be around the low-mid £20,000s. A large amount! There are around 120 households attached to our congregation. If **100** of them increased their giving by **£1** per week this would increase our income by £5200 pa. If the increase was £2 per week the increase in income would be £10400 and so on. When Gift -Aid returns and, hopefully, halls lets are added on the deficit is likely to become a more manageable figure. While the present level of building repair costs will not continue at such a high level, the cost of maintaining our extensive buildings and the usual costs of Ministry etc. remains high. The Vestry ask that we all prayerfully consider our level of giving and ask if we can contribute that relatively small increase that would make such as difference to our finances going forward.
